Grilling Time is always in Season

No matter the outdoor temperature nothing beats a meal cooked on the grill but we want to remember to keep our grilling safety tips in mind for a safe (and delicious) backyard barbecue. Be sure to give the grill enough space. You may want to stand in the shade when you're grilling, but having an awning or tree branch too close

to the grill can be dangerous. Floating embers can easily spark a fire! Your grill—whether it's gas or charcoal, should be at least 10 feet away from deck railings and any structures. A grill too close to the siding can cause it to melt. Also give yourself enough space, use long handled tools especially made for cooking on the grill."

Final Condo Construction Phase

The long awaited construction of the last condo to be built at Stonebrook began July 2021. The condo units have over 1700+ square footage, 2 bedrooms, and 2 full baths. There will be a walk out from the basement. Completion date is dependent upon availability of materials. The first condo was built in 2006. When this last condo is finished there will be 49 units in the Stonebrook community which includes the patio homes and the individual condo units. If you have friends that wanted to live in our community, it's too late, these condo units are sold!
